JUNE 9-12 — BOYS RESIDENT/DAY CAMP

Boys only – Grades 6-10

All campers should arrive at Ban Johnson Arena between 5:30 and 6:30 p.m. on Monday, June 9. First meal will be breakfast on Tuesday, June 10, and last meal will be lunch on June 12. Check-out time will be 5:00 p.m. on June 12. Cost is \$330 for resident campers (\$300 for second member of the same family) and \$270 for day campers (\$240 for second day camper, from the same family). Day campers may leave at 9:00 p.m. each night and arrive at 8:30 a.m. each day (no breakfast for day campers). (Only discount the second member).

What to bring: Playing clothes, shoes, socks, swim trunks and towels, One set of bedding to fit a twin-size bed, pillow, and fan (if desired), money for concession stand and pizza at night.

CAMP PHILOSOPHY

The Pioneer Basketball Camp, LLC is designed to give full attention to each camper. The camp philosophy assures that the fundamentals of basketball will be taught and each camper will receive the individual instruction necessary to become a better player. The camp staff consists of top college and high school coaches from Ohio, as well as current Marietta College players and the entire Marietta College basketball staff. JUNE 23-25 — DAY CAMP

Boys and Girls – Grades 2-5

Campers should arrive between 8:00-9:00 a.m. Monday, June 23 at the Dyson Baudo Recreation Center for registration. Day camp begins each day at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. Campers will need to pack their own lunch on Monday and Tuesday. Pizza will be provided for lunch on Wednesday.

There will be separate sessions and games for boys and girls along with 5 hours of total instruction each day.

Cost is \$140 (\$120 a piece with two members from the same family). Camp will conclude at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday June 25.

What to bring: Playing clothes and basketball shoes, extra money for concession stand.
